Remonstrance Period

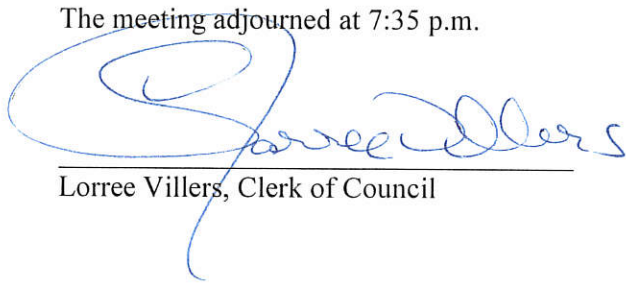

Mayor Pribonic awarded two (2) resident young good Samaritans Certificates; one for picking up rubbish and one for shoveling snow.

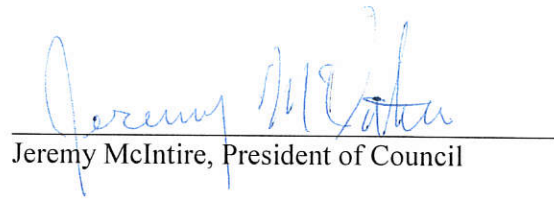
Adjournment
