Jaime Syx stated there is a power outage in the City of Stow on Berger Avenue. There are many residents currently without power and several have medical issues; some are on oxygen and other residents have issues that a power outage causes severe hardship. The power outage will likely remain in place until Tuesday, 3/28/2023. Before the Board is a request to approve a dollar amount to secure rooms at the Fairfield Inn in Stow, Ohio for residents from Berger Avenue.

Nick Wren stated the amount of the requisition is not to exceed \$5,000.00 payable to the Fairfield Inn, Stow, Ohio.

Mayor Pribonic moved to approve this item; seconded by Jaime Syx. Discussion: Mayor Pribonic stated both Jim Costello and Jim McCleary were both notified of this emergency meeting however both are currently out of town and unable to attend. Nick Wren called for the vote. Motion Passed: three (3) yays, zero (0) nays, two (2) members absent.

Mayor Pribonic moved to adjourn; seconded by Jaime Syx. There was no further discussion and the meeting adjourned at 4:02 p.m.

I am a citizen of Stow, Ohio. I, on behalf of myself, and others who reside within my residence, acknowledge and fully assume the risk of injury, illness, damages or death arising from or as a result of my hotel stay at the Fairfield Inn, 4170 Steels Pointe, Stow, Ohio 44224 (hereinafter "Hotel"), as a result of the electrical power outage occurring at Berger Avenue, Stow, Ohio. The dates of the Hotel stay will not exceed March 26, 2023 through March 28, 2023. The City of Stow will provide the Hotel stay which includes the amount for the room and taxes. The City will not be responsible for any additional charges. On behalf of myself and my successors, assigns, and other legal representatives hereby absolutely, unconditionally and irrevocably, covenant and agree to forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the City of Stow, its officials, elected or otherwise, agents, employees, contractors, and assigns hereinafter referred to as the "City" from any liability related to my/our Hotel stay.

I shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments, losses or expenses of any nature whatsoever (including, without limitation, attorney fees, costs and disbursements, whether of in-house or outside counsel and whether or not an action is brought, on appeal or otherwise), arising from or out of, or relating to, directly or indirectly, arising from or as a result of my/our Hotel stay.

IN SIGNING THIS WAIVER, I ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT I have read the foregoing Waiver, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed; no oral representations, statements, or inducements have been made; I or my parent/legal guardian am/is at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this Agreement for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.
