Call to Order

Chairman Feldman called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

Motion made Riehl by seconded by Lowdermilk for approval of Minutes of the Roads & Safety Committee Meeting of March 10, 2022. Vote – Yeas: Feldman, Lowdermilk, McIntire, Riehl. Nays: None. Motion carried unanimously.

Business Item(s)

Update – Road Program (2021/2022)

Mr. Feldman provide a background of the road program. He stated that Perrin Asphalt was award the Asphalt and Concrete programs this year. JD Striping was award the striping program and Spano Brothers were award the sidewalk program.

Mr. Wren stated that it was a benefit to have one contractor for the Asphalt and Concrete program this year. He stated that curbs repairs and marked first before the asphalt streets will be complete. He also stated that there was a pre-construction meeting scheduled for the sidewalk program. Mr. Wren stated that the completion of the 2021 program was in progress. The 2021 program would be finished in this spring. The 2022 program will begin on May 2, 2022. All the programs are to be completed by September 2, 2022.

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The City has increased fines in the contract to meet deadlines. He noted that all the contracts came in under budget this year, but he did stated that he overestimate the quotes based on overall inflation. Mrs. Harrison asked when the re-rating of roads would be completed. Mr. Wren stated that it would be completed by fall to benefit next year's program. The roads were last rated in 2017.


Remonstrance Period

The meeting adjourned at 5:44 p.m.


