Exemption Certificate for Retired Individuals

Due Date: April 18, 2022

As a convenience to retirees, the City of Stow Income Tax Department allows retirees who receive only non-taxable income such as: Social Security, Pensions, Dividends or Interest to file an **Exemption Certificate**.

- In order to qualify for this Exemption, please complete the form below and return it to the City of Stow Income Tax office at PO BOX 1668, Stow, Ohio 44224. If filing a Joint return and you, or your spouse, have any kind of taxable income, you are **not eligible** for this exemption.
- Once you sign the Exemption Certificate for Retired Individuals, and in the future, you or your spouse receive taxable income, the Exemption Certificate will not be valid and you will be required to file a City of Stow Income Tax return.
Example: If you begin working, start a business, own rental property, or receive lottery winnings, you will be required to file a City of Stow Income Tax return.
- If, in the future you are required to file a City of Stow Income Tax return, you must notify this office.
- If you do not return this form, it will be your responsibility to file a City of Stow Income Tax return each year.
