

WANT A NEW TREE?

It's as Easy as 1, 2, 3!

Help keep the City of Stow beautiful for future generations! The City's Urban Forestry Department will plant a tree in your tree lawn or private yard (front or side) for a small fee.



HOW THE TREE PLANTING PROGRAM WORKS

1

Submit an Application (and \$125 Fee) by Oct. 31.

All City of Stow homeowners are eligible to apply. Resident cost is \$125* per tree, which includes the purchase of a two-inch caliper tree, installation, watering bag and tree guard.

2

Applications Reviewed & Yards Inspected by Stow's Landscape Arborist.

Tree lawns must be at least 5-feet wide to qualify. Applications will be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis until funds for the year run out. Remaining applications will move to the next year.

3

Trees Planted!

Trees will be selected and planted by City of Stow staff each spring. If in private yard, the tree selection will be made in conjunction with the property owner. Trees are guaranteed for one year from the date of planting. The City will perform maintenance and fill watering bags on tree-lawn trees. Homeowners are responsible for trees in private yards.

*Stow veterans or active duty military personnel providing verification of "honorable" military status may receive a \$50 discount per tree. Stow residents who are unable to pay the associated fee and have properly completed a Tree Planting Program – Affidavit of Indigence may receive one free tree.
